Where are we...


- Newcastle upon Tyne to Carlisle 60 miles with 14 stations

Angelou Centre Newcastle




We have engaged with new audiences in two ways:

Syrian Refugees in Gateshead




We have a base at Haltwhistle, 35 miles from Newcastle..

- Week day and a Saturday




Lots of learning from Angelou...


Community art - where to start???


See what other groups do...better to find your niche!

Our idea came from walking here...






Former TMD:
