# **Getaway Programme Background and Objectives**

**2** minutes walk from Gloucester Railway Station...

**Barton and Tredworth, the most** ethnically diverse ward in **Gloucestershire**, is classified as a highly deprived area nationally

41.4% of Barton and Tredworth's population are from a diverse ethnic group

For almost all diverse ethnic groups health related quality of life is worse compared to white British people. The benefits of being in the outdoors are well known but...

Only 1% of visitors to UK national parks come from BAME backgrounds. Safety Concerns and Racial Discrimination...

More than nine in 10 journeys to national parks are made by car... Between 2015-2019 - Black people more than twice as likely as White people to live in a household with no access to a car or van Getaway addresses social inequalities allowing black/brown youth to access mental health and wellbeing benefits of being out in nature.



## **Engaging & Empowering**

The research matches our idea...but what does the community want?

We built on personal relationships in the community by approaching trusted community organisation.

We ensured our project goals aligned with the community organisation goals.

We communicated what resources we have and what we were offering.





It's like any other relationship... You have to build trust. And trust takes time!

Giving the young people the opportunity to co-design the experiences as a group, with trusted youth leaders from their own organisation

What are the leaders concerns? What are my concerns and what can I do?





# The Impact of Building Trust Over Time

Getaway Year 1: 10 day trips for 117 young people

Getaway Year 2 so far... 5 day trips for 121 young people
